

Microsoft made a commitment to provide 10 years of product support for Windows 7 when it was released on 22 October 2009.

When this 10-year period ends, Microsoft will discontinue Windows 7 support to focus on supporting newer technologies like Windows 10.

The last day of support for Windows 7 will be 14 January 2020. After that automatic updates that help protect your PC will no longer be made by Microsoft.

Microsoft recommends that you move to Windows 10 sometime before January 2020 to ensure your business continues to run smoothly.

WHY UPGRADE TO WIN10

- Hardware providers will no longer provide updates for Windows 7 devices.
- Software providers will no longer provide updates to software, supporting Windows 7.
- Windows 7 was built on code from 2009.
 Windows 10's code is faster and more secure.



No Security Updates

Microsoft will no longer provide updates. This makes your computer vulnerable.



Upgrade Compatibility

Only some PC's can be upgraded to Win10. Many PC's will need to be completely replaced.



Program Compatibility

Program developers will stop future updates. Programs will eventually malfunction.
